Camp DeSoto. Community Engagement Coordinator. 2025.

Beginning in January 2025, I joined the full-time staff of Camp DeSoto. Responsible for all things creative, I create all in-house and external design materials, manage our social media, maintain our two websites, create two 70 page yearbooks for campers, design merchandise, and more. Additionally in the summer, I daily photograph, cull, edit, and upload hundreds of photos for parents to view back home – and for campers to later relive their memories. I create a personal schedule to ensure all campers are photographed as equally as possible, as well as ensuring we have a overarching representation of the day's happenings.

Camp DeSoto. Photographer. Summer 2023 + 2024.

In addition to photographing, culling, and uploading daily, I was on LEAD Team. In May, I began a summer internship with Daxko's Product/UX team, which shifted into a part-time role that fall. My initial task over the summer was transitioning the company to a new roadmapping software. I set up the software, integrated it with our other applications, and trained coworkers on its usage and best practices. Additionally, I collaborated with the UX team on projects and created data readouts of customer feedback, surveys, and project updates for the Senior Leadership Team's weekly review. I also helped redesign the UI on one of our enterprise applications that serves the YMCA and Boys and Girls Club markets.
